American Red Cross heroes help disaster victims recover. They give blood to help a hospital patient. They brighten the day of an injured service member. They step forward to help someone having a heart attack.

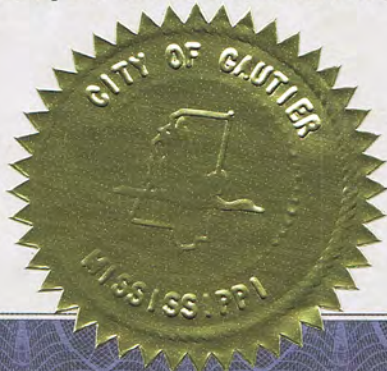
We would like to remember our heroes here in Gautier, Mississippi who help people in need. They work tirelessly to assist their neighbors when they need a helping hand.

GAUTIER, MS – The Gautier Police Department is honoring Sergeant Walt Konrad, a 30 year police veteran and 4 time medal of valor recipient with the award of "Officer of the Year" for 2014. 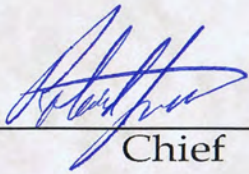
Firefighter Josh Latch is a devoted employee and asset to the City of Gautier and we would like to congratulate him for this accomplishment and thank him for his service to the community.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 004-2015

RESOLUTION REQUESTING PASSAGE OF A LOCAL AND PRIVATE BILL TO AUTHORIZE THE CITIES OF PASCAGOULA AND GAUTIER TO ESTABLISH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREAS WITHIN EXISTING URBAN RENEWAL AREAS IN THE CITIES; TO REQUIRE REDEVELOPMENT TRUST FUNDS TO BE CREATED FOR SUCH AREAS; TO PROVIDE THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH FUNDS IN SUCH TRUST FUNDS MAY BE UTILIZED, INCLUDING THE AWARDING OF GRANTS TO PRIVATE REAL PROPERTY OWNERS TO PAY THE COST OF EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR IMPROVEMENTS TO PROPERTY IN THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA THAT WILL RESULT IN THE IMPROVED APPEARANCE AND FUNCTIONALITY OF THE PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY INCREASE IN SALES TAXES COLLECTED IN THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA AND DIVERTED TO THE MUNICIPALITIES SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE REDEVELOPMENT TRUST FUND FOR THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AREA TO FUND THE GRANTS AUTHORIZED THEREBY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Pascagoula has partnered with the City of Gautier to promote certain legislation to create community redevelopment areas within existing urban renewal areas whereby cities can incentivize commercial and residential development within certain defined areas in the municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City Councils of the Cities of Pascagoula and Gautier are of the opinion that such legislation would be enormously beneficial to their cities which are still dealing with the effects of lost property from Hurricane Katrina and seek local incentives to spur development ; and

WHEREAS, the City Councils support a local and private bill for the cities of Gautier and Pascagoula so that these two cities can take advantage of the benefits of such legislation:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Councils of the Cities of Pascagoula and Gautier request that its local delegation immediately sponsor a local and private bill authorizing the creation of community redevelopment areas within the existing urban renewal areas of the cities of Pascagoula and Gautier and making provisions for the creation of redevelopment trust funds and further authorizing that such trust funds may be used to incentivize commercial and residential redevelopment within the community redevelopment areas.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is directed to cause certified copies of this Resolution, together with its attachment, to be immediately transmitted to all of the local delegation for the cities of Pascagoula and Gautier.

SUBJECT: Lease Agreement for North Substation

REQUEST:

The Gautier Police Department is requesting authorization to proceed with the Lease Agreement between Martin Bluff Baptist Church and the City of Gautier in order to establish a substation in the Hickory Hills community.

BACKGROUND:

The Gautier Police Department would like to move forward with a binding lease agreement between Martin Bluff Baptist Church and the City of Gautier. The agreement will allow the police department to move forward in utilizing the parsonage as a substation in Hickory Hills community.

DISCUSSION:

The Gautier Police Department currently has a substation in south Gautier. This helps to facilitate law enforcement activities in the De La Forest and College Park community. We are seeking to establish a north police substation in the Hickory Hills community. The placement of substations builds on the City's existing neighborhood policing programs and strengthens business/police relations. In the north area of Gautier, we currently have one thoroughfare that leads in and out of the community. In the event of a natural disaster, having a substation will allow dedicated officers to be based in the affected area, without the need to return to the main police department. Police field operations can be conducted and handled through the substations.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Gautier Police Department recommends the Mayor and City Council to authorize Lease Agreement with Martin Bluff Baptist Church.

LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS LEASE, made and entered into on this the ____ day of _____, AD., 2015, by and between Martin Bluff Baptist Church, hereinafter designated as “Lessors” and The City of Gautier, hereinafter designated as “Lessee”.

1. Lessors hereby lease and let unto Lessee for a period of five (5) years beginning on the date of execution of this lease by both parties, and ending on the five (5) year anniversary of same, for the rental hereinafter set out, on the following described property, located at 1412 Hastings Rd., Gautier, MS 39553.
2. The “rental property” shall consist of the parsonage, the front yard of the parsonage, and the back yard of the parsonage, all located at 1412 Hastings Rd., Gautier, MS 39553. An approximation of the leased premises has been attached as “Exhibit A” to this agreement.
3. Lessee does hereby accept this Lease and the herein described property, subject to the terms and condition thereof, and agrees to pay for utilities, termite protection, and fire, wind, and hazard insurance. The above contracts will remain in the Lessors’ name, but the Lessee will provide payments to the relevant providers on a monthly basis. The city will provide pest control service.
4. In exchange for, and in consideration of the use of the rental property, Lessee agrees to make certain improvements to the rental property, as described further herein.
5. The terms and conditions of this Lease, to which the Parties hereto subscribe and bind themselves, are as follows:
 - a. The Lessors will do the following:
 - i. The Lessors will keep the leased premises free from all liens or encumbrances that would interfere or might interfere with the Lessee’s enjoyment of the use of said property.
 - ii. Pay all ad valorem taxes and special assessments legally assessed against said real

property.

- iii. Maintain Fire, Wind and Hazard Insurance on the building.
- iv. Provide copies of such policies to the City upon request.

b. The Lessee will do the following:

- i. Provide all maintenance on the premises leased unto the Lessee.
- ii. Occupy and use said property and exercise reasonable diligence and prudence in the reservation thereof and not subject the same to any damage. In the event Lessee makes or causes to be made any improvements to said property, said improvements shall be approved by Lessors, in writing. All additions or improvements approved by the parties (except for office furniture, items, and fixtures which shall be readily removable without injury to the premises), shall be and remain a part of the premises at the expiration of this lease.
- iii. Furnish at its own expense all utilities it may need, and janitorial services.
- iv. Make certain improvements to the rental property, including creation of a driveway attached to the parsonage, and other improvements as agreed by the parties in writing.
- v. Maintain and keep the yard and premises neat, clean, cut, trimmed and watered.
- vi. Maintain the premises and deliver forthwith, at the expiration of this Lease, possession of the property to Lessors in the same condition, ordinary wear and tear excepted, as at the time it entered into possession thereof.
- vii. Pay the specified monthly expenses, as described above.

6. The Lessors and Lessee herein agree that the premises are being leased in its "AS IS, WHERE IS" condition.

7. All of the terms, provisions, conditions, and agreements contained in this Lease Agreement are to apply to and be binding on the parties hereto, their heirs, representatives, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, and whenever in this Lease a reference to any of the parties herein is made, such reference shall be deemed to include, wherever appropriate, their heirs, representative, executors, administrators, successors or assigns.

8. Irrespective of the place of execution or performance, this Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, and all transactions shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi. This Contract shall be construed without regard to any presumption or other rule requiring construction against the party causing this Contract to be drafted. If any words or phrases in this Contract shall have been stricken or otherwise eliminated, whether or not any other words or phrases have been added, this Contract shall be construed as if the words or phrases so stricken or eliminated were never included in this Contract and no implication or reference shall be drawn from the fact that said words or phrases were so stricken or otherwise eliminated. All terms and words used in this Contract, regardless of the number or gender in which they are used, shall be deemed to include any other number and any other gender as the context may require.
9. A photo static, copy, facsimile or electronic signature of this document or separate acknowledgment or approval of same shall have the same force and effect as "ink" signatures and shall act as a fully executed original and that third parties may rely upon same.

REQUEST:

City Council authorization is requested for the City of Gautier to accept the renewal agreement for the mailing machine between the City of Gautier and Pitney Bowes, Inc. in the amount of \$140.99 monthly or billed quarterly at \$422.97.

BACKGROUND:

Pitney Bowes, Inc. has provided a postage machine to the City of Gautier in order to increase efficiency through automation and reducing the amount of individual-piece handling of mail.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the attached information from Pitney Bowes, Inc. City staff recommends that City Council authorize the renewal agreement for the mailing machine in the amount of \$140.99 or billed quarterly in the amount of \$422.97.

RENTAL AGREEMENT
FOR USE BY MISSISSIPPI AGENCIES & GOVERNING AUTHORITIES
AND VENDORS
(applicable to equipment rental transactions)

This Rental Agreement (hereinafter referred to as Agreement) is entered into by and between _____ (hereinafter referred to as Customer), and _____ (hereinafter referred to as Vendor). This Agreement becomes effective upon signature by Customer and Vendor, and shall take precedence over all agreements and understandings between the parties. Vendor, by its acceptance hereof, agrees to rent to Customer, and Customer, by its acceptance hereof, agrees to rent from Vendor, the equipment, including applicable software and services to render it continually operational, listed in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

1. **CUSTOMER ACCOUNT ESTABLISHMENT:**

- A. A separate Vendor Customer Number will be required for each specific customer/installation location.
- B. The Customer is identified as the entity on the first line of the "bill-to" address. All invoices and notices of changes will be sent to the "bill-to" address in accordance with Paragraph 8 herein.
- C. Ship-to and/or Installed-at address is the location to which the initial shipment of equipment/supplies will be made and the address to which service representatives will respond. Subsequent shipments of supplies for installed equipment will also be delivered to the "installed-at" address unless otherwise requested.
- D. Unless creditworthiness for this Customer Number has been previously established by Vendor, Vendor's Credit Department may conduct a credit investigation for this Agreement. Notwithstanding delivery of equipment, Vendor may revoke this Agreement by written notice to the Customer if credit approval is denied within thirty (30) days after the date this Agreement is accepted for Vendor by an authorized representative.

2. **EQUIPMENT SELECTION, PRICES, AND AGREEMENT:** The Customer has selected and Vendor agrees to provide the equipment, including applicable software and services to render it continually operational, identified on Exhibit A attached to this Agreement. The specific prices, inclusive of applicable transportation charges, are as set forth on the attached Exhibit A. The parties understand and agree that the Customer is exempt from the payment of taxes.

3. **SHIPPING AND TRANSPORTATION:** Vendor agrees to pay all non-priority, ground shipping, transportation, rigging and drayage charges for the equipment from the equipment's place of manufacture to the installation address of the equipment as specified under this Agreement. If any form of express shipping method is requested, it will be paid for by Customer.

4. **RISK OF LOSS OR DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT:** While in transit, Vendor shall assume and bear the entire risk of loss and damage to the equipment from any cause whatsoever. If, during the period the equipment is in Customer's possession, due to gross negligence of the customer, the equipment is lost or damaged, then, the customer shall bear the cost of replacing or repairing said equipment.

5. **DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, ACCEPTANCE, AND RELOCATION:**

A. **DELIVERY:** Vendor shall deliver the equipment to the location specified by Customer and pursuant to the delivery schedule agreed upon by the parties. If, through no fault of the Customer, Vendor is unable to deliver the equipment or software, the prices, terms and conditions will remain unchanged until delivery is made by Vendor. If, however, Vendor does not deliver the equipment or software within ten (10) working days of the delivery due date, Customer shall have the right to terminate the order without penalty, cost or expense to Customer of any kind whatsoever.

B. INSTALLATION SITE: At the time of delivery and during the period Vendor is responsible for maintenance of the equipment, the equipment installation site must conform to Vendor's published space, electrical and environmental requirements; and the Customer agrees to provide, at no charge, reasonable access to the equipment and to a telephone for local or toll free calls.

C. INSTALLATION DATE: The installation date of the equipment shall be that date as is agreed upon by the parties, if Vendor is responsible for installing the equipment.

D. ACCEPTANCE: Unless otherwise agreed to by the parties, Vendor agrees that Customer shall have ten (10) working days from date of delivery and installation, to inspect, evaluate and test the equipment to confirm that it is in good working order.

E. RELOCATION: Customer may transfer equipment to a new location by notifying Vendor in writing of the transfer at least thirty (30) calendar days before the move is made. If Vendor is responsible for maintenance of the equipment this notice will enable Vendor to provide technical assistance in the relocation efforts, if needed, as well as to update Vendor's records as to machine location. There will be no cessation of rental charges during the period of any such transfer. The Vendor's cost of moving and reinstalling equipment from one location to another is not included in this Agreement, and Customer agrees to pay Vendor, after receipt of invoice of Vendor's charges with respect to such moving of equipment, which will be billed to Customer in accordance with Vendor's standard practice then in effect for commercial users of similar equipment or software and payment remitted in accordance with Paragraph 8 herein.

6. RENTAL TERM: The rental term for each item of equipment shall be that as stated in the attached Exhibit A. If the Customer desires to continue renting the equipment at the expiration of the original rental agreement, the Customer must enter into a new rental agreement which shall be separate from this Agreement. There will be no automatic renewals allowed. There shall be no option to purchase.

7. OWNERSHIP: Unless the Customer has obtained title to the equipment, title to the equipment shall be and remain vested at all times in Vendor or its assignee and nothing in this Agreement shall give or convey to Customer any right, title or interest therein, unless purchased by Customer. Nameplates, stencils or other indicia of Vendor's ownership affixed or to be affixed to the equipment shall not be removed or obliterated by Customer.

8. PAYMENTS:

A. INVOICING AND PAYMENTS: The charges for the equipment, software or services covered by this Agreement are specified in the attached Exhibit A. Charges for any partial month for any item of equipment shall be prorated based on a thirty (30) day month. Vendor shall submit an invoice with the appropriate documentation to Customer.

1. E-PAYMENT: The Vendor agrees to accept all payments in United States currency via the State of Mississippi's electronic payment and remittance vehicle. The Customer agrees to make payment in accordance with Mississippi law on "Timely Payments for Purchases by Public Bodies", Section 31-7-301, *et seq.* of the 1972 Mississippi Code Annotated, as amended, which generally provides for payment of undisputed amounts by the agency within forty-five (45) days of receipt of the invoice.

2. PAYMODE: Payments by state agencies using the Statewide Automated Accounting System (SAAS) shall be made and remittance information provided electronically as directed by the Customer. These payments shall be deposited into the bank account of the Vendor's choice. The Customer, may at its sole discretion, require the Vendor to submit invoices and supporting documentation electronically at any time during the term of this Agreement. The Vendor understands and agrees that the Customer is exempt from the payment of taxes. All payments shall be in United States currency.

B. METER READINGS: If applicable, the Customer shall provide accurate and timely meter readings at the end

of each applicable billing period on the forms or other alternative means specified by Vendor. Vendor shall have the right, upon reasonable prior notice to Customer, and during Customer's regular business hours, to inspect the equipment and to monitor the meter readings. If Customer meter readings are not received in the time to be agreed upon by the parties, the meter readings may be obtained electronically or by other means or may be estimated by Vendor subject to reconciliation when the correct meter reading is received by Vendor.

C. **COPY CREDITS:** If applicable, if a copier is being rented, the Customer will receive one (1) copy credit for each copy presented to Vendor which, in the Customer's opinion, is unusable and also for each copy which was produced during servicing of the equipment. Copy credits will be issued only if Vendor is responsible for providing equipment services or maintenance services (except time and materials maintenance). Copy credits will be reflected on the invoice as a reduction in the total copy volume, except for run length plans which will be credited at a specific copy credit rate as shown on the applicable price list.

9. **USE OF EQUIPMENT:** Customer shall operate the equipment according to the manufacturer's specifications and documented instructions. Customer agrees not to employ or use additional attachments, features or devices on the equipment or make changes or alterations to the equipment covered hereby without the prior written consent of Vendor in each case, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.

10. **MAINTENANCE SERVICES, EXCLUSIONS, AND REMEDIES:**

A. **SERVICES:** If Vendor is responsible for providing equipment services, maintenance services (except for time and materials), or warranty services: (1) Vendor shall install and maintain the equipment and make all necessary adjustments and repairs to keep the equipment in good working order. (2) Parts required for repair may be used or reprocessed in accordance with Vendor's specifications and replaced parts are the property of Vendor, unless otherwise specifically provided on the price lists. (3) Services will be provided during Customer's usual business hours. (4) If applicable, Customer will permit Vendor to install, at no cost to Customer, all retrofits designated by Vendor as mandatory or which are designed to insure accuracy of meters.

B. **EXCLUSIONS:** The following is not within the scope of services: (1) Provision and installation of optional retrofits. (2) Services connected with equipment relocation. (3) Installation/removal of accessories, attachments or other devices. (4) Exterior painting or refinishing of equipment. (5) Maintenance, installation or removal of equipment or devices not provided by Vendor. (6) Performance of normal operator functions as described in applicable Vendor operator manuals. (7) Performance of services necessitated by accident; power failure; unauthorized alteration of equipment or software; tampering; service by someone other than Vendor; causes other than ordinary use; interconnection of equipment by electrical, or electronic or mechanical means with noncompatible equipment, or failure to use operating system software. If Vendor provides, at the request of the Customer, any of the services noted above, the Customer may be billed by Vendor at a rate not to exceed the Master State Prices Agreement between the Vendor and the State of Mississippi, or in the absence of such agreement at the then current time and materials rates.

C. **REMEDIES:** If during the period in which Vendor is providing maintenance services, Vendor is unable to maintain the equipment in good working order, Vendor will, at no additional charge, provide either an identical replacement or another product that provides equal or greater capabilities.

11. **HOLD HARMLESS:** To the fullest extent allowed by law, Vendor shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless, protect, and exonerate the Customer and the State of Mississippi, its Commissioners, Board Members, officers, employees, agents, and representatives from and against all claims, demands, liabilities, suits, actions, damages, losses, and costs of every kind and nature whatsoever, including, without limitation, court costs, investigative fees and expenses, and attorneys' fees, arising out of or caused by Vendor and/or its partners, principals, agents, employees, and/or subcontractors in the performance of or failure to perform this Agreement. In the Customer's sole discretion, Vendor may be allowed to control the defense of any such claim, suit, etc. In the event Vendor defends said claim, suit, etc., Vendor shall use legal counsel acceptable to the Customer; Vendor shall be solely liable for all reasonable costs and/or expenses associated with such defense and the Customer shall be entitled to participate in said defense. Vendor shall not settle any claim, suit, etc., without the Customer's concurrence,

which the Customer shall not unreasonably withhold.

12. ALTERATIONS, ATTACHMENTS, AND SUPPLIES:

A. If Customer makes an alteration, attaches a device or utilizes a supply item that increases the cost of services Vendor will either propose an additional service charge or request that the equipment be returned to its standard configuration or that use of the supply item be discontinued. If, within five (5) days of such proposal or request, Customer does not remedy the problem or agree in writing to do so within a reasonable amount of time, Vendor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement as provided herein. If Vendor believes that an alteration, attachment or supply item affects the safety of Vendor personnel or equipment users, Vendor shall notify Customer of the problem and may withhold maintenance until the problem is remedied.

B. Unless Customer has obtained title to the equipment free and clear of any Vendor security interest, Customer may not remove any ownership identification tags on the equipment or allow the equipment to become fixtures to real property.

13. ASSIGNMENT: The Vendor shall not assign, subcontract or otherwise transfer in whole or in part, its right or obligations under this Agreement without prior written consent of the Customer. Any attempted assignment or transfer without said consent shall be void and of no effect.

14. GOVERNING LAW: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, excluding its conflicts of laws provisions, and any litigation with respect thereto shall be brought in the courts of said state. The Vendor shall comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

15. NOTICE: Any notice required or permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and personally delivered or sent by certified United States mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, to the party to whom the notice should be given at the address set forth below. Notice shall be deemed given when actually received or when refused. The parties agree to promptly notify each other in writing of any change of address.

16. WAIVER: Failure by the Customer at any time to enforce the provisions of this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver of any such provisions. Such failure to enforce shall not affect the validity of this Agreement or any part thereof or the right of the Customer to enforce any provision at any time in accordance with its terms.

17. CAPTIONS: The captions or headings in this Agreement are for convenience only, and in no way define, limit or describe the scope or intent of any provision or section of this Agreement.

18. SEVERABILITY: If any term or provision of this Agreement is prohibited by the laws of the State of Mississippi or declared invalid or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

19. THIRD PARTY ACTION NOTIFICATION: Vendor shall give Customer prompt notice in writing of any action or suit filed, and prompt notice of any claim made against Vendor by any entity that may result in litigation related in any way to this Agreement.

20. AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT: Vendor warrants that it is a validly organized business with valid authority to enter into this Agreement and that entry into and performance under this Agreement is not restricted or prohibited by any loan,

security, financing, contractual or other agreement of any kind, and notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement to the contrary, that there are no existing legal proceedings, or prospective legal proceedings, either voluntary or otherwise, which may adversely affect its ability to perform its obligations under this Agreement.

21. **RECORD RETENTION AND ACCESS TO RECORDS:** The Vendor agrees that the Customer or any of its duly authorized representatives at any time during the term of this Agreement shall have unimpeded, prompt access to and the right to audit and examine any pertinent books, documents, papers, and records of the Vendor related to the Vendor's charges and performance under this Agreement. All records related to this Agreement shall be kept by the Vendor for a period of three (3) years after final payment under this Agreement and all pending matters are closed unless the Customer authorizes their earlier disposition. However, if any litigation, claim, negotiation, audit or other action arising out of or related in any way to this Agreement has been started before the expiration of the three (3) year period, the records shall be retained for one (1) year after all issues arising out of the action are finally resolved. The Vendor agrees to refund to the Customer any overpayment disclosed by any such audit arising out of or related in any way to this Agreement.
22. **EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES:** If either party is rendered unable, wholly or in part, by reason of strikes, accidents, acts of God, weather conditions or any other acts beyond its control and without its fault or negligence to comply with any obligations or performance required under this Agreement, then such party shall have the option to suspend its obligations or performance hereunder until the extraordinary performance circumstances are resolved. If the extraordinary performance circumstances are not resolved within a reasonable period of time, however, the non-defaulting party shall have the option, upon prior written notice, of terminating the Agreement.
23. **TERMINATION:** This Agreement may be terminated as follows: (a) Customer and Vendor mutually agree to the termination, or (b) If either party fails to comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement and that breach continues for thirty (30) days after the defaulting party receives written notice from the other party, then the non-defaulting party has the right to terminate this Agreement. The non-defaulting party may also pursue any remedy available to it in law or in equity. Upon termination, all obligations of Customer to make payments required hereunder shall cease.
24. **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS:** It is expressly understood and agreed that the obligation of the Customer to proceed under this Agreement is conditioned upon the appropriation of funds by the Mississippi State Legislature and the receipt of state and/or federal funds. If the funds anticipated for the continuing fulfillment of the agreement are, at any time, not forthcoming or insufficient, either through the failure of the federal government to provide funds or of the State of Mississippi to appropriate funds or the discontinuance or material alteration of the program under which funds were provided or if funds are not otherwise available to the Customer, the Customer shall have the right upon ten (10) working days written notice to the Vendor, to terminate this Agreement without damage, penalty, cost or expenses to the Customer of any kind whatsoever. The effective date of termination shall be as specified in the notice of termination.
25. **MODIFICATION OR RENEGOTIATION:** This Agreement may be modified, altered or changed only by written agreement signed by the parties hereto. The parties agree to renegotiate the Agreement if federal, state and/or the Customer's revisions of any applicable laws or regulations make changes in this Agreement necessary.
26. **WARRANTIES:** Vendor warrants that the equipment, when operated according to the manufacturer's specifications and documented instructions, shall perform the functions indicated by the specifications and documented literature. Vendor may be held liable for any damages caused by failure of the equipment to function according to specifications and documented literature published by the manufacturer of the equipment.
27. **E-VERIFY COMPLIANCE:** If applicable, the Vendor represents and warrants that it will ensure its compliance with the Mississippi Employment Protection Act of 2008, Section 71-11-1, *et seq.* of the Mississippi Code Annotated (Supp 2008), and will register and participate in the status verification system for all newly hired employees. The term "employee" as used herein means any person that is hired to perform work within the State of Mississippi. As used herein, "status verification system" means the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigration Responsibility Act of 1996 that is operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security, also known as the E-Verify Program, or any other successor electronic verification system replacing the E-Verify Program. The Vendor agrees to maintain records of such compliance and, upon request of the State and

approval of the Social Security Administration or Department of Homeland Security, where required, to provide a copy of each such verification to the Customer. The Vendor further represents and warrants that any person assigned to perform services hereafter meets the employment eligibility requirements of all immigration laws of these warranties, the breach of which may subject the Vendor to the following: (1) termination of this Agreement and ineligibility for any state or public contract in Mississippi for up to three (3) years, with notice of such cancellation/termination being made public, or (2) the loss of any license, permit, certification or other document granted to the Vendor by an agency, department or governmental entity for the right to do business in Mississippi for up to one (1) year, or (3) both --in the event of such cancellation/termination, the Vendor would also be liable for any additional costs incurred by the Customer due to the contract cancellation or loss of license or permit.

28. HARD DRIVE SECURITY: Vendor must properly format the hard drive, deleting all information, or replace the hard drive with a new hard drive prior to storing or re-selling the equipment. The Customer may request to retain the hard drive for a nominal fee. Vendor will supply written notification to the Customer that all data has been made inaccessible. This notification must be provided with forty-five (45) days of the equipment being returned to the Vendor.

29. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the equipment, software or services described herein and supersedes and replaces any and all prior negotiations, understandings and agreements, written or oral, between the parties relating hereto. No terms, conditions, understandings, usages of the trade, course of dealings or agreements, not specifically set out in this Agreement or incorporated herein, shall be effective or relevant to modify, vary, explain or supplement this Agreement.

30. TRANSPARENCY: This Agreement, including any accompanying exhibits, attachments, and appendices, is subject to the "Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983," codified as Section 25-61-1 et seq., Mississippi Code Annotated and exceptions found in Section 79-23-1 of the Mississippi Code Annotated (1972, as amended). In addition, this Agreement is subject to provisions of the Mississippi Accountability and Transparency Act of 2008 (MATA), codified as Section 27-104-151 of the Mississippi Code Annotated (1972, as amended). Unless exempted from disclosure due to a court-issued protective order, this Agreement is required to be posted to the Department of Finance and Administration's independent agency contract website for public access. Prior to posting the Agreement to the website, any information identified by the Vendor as trade secrets, or other proprietary information including confidential vendor information, or any other information which is required confidential by state or federal law or outside the applicable freedom of information statutes will be redacted. A fully executed copy of this Agreement shall be posted to the State of Mississippi's accountability website at: <http://www.transparency.mississippi.gov>.

31. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: The Vendor understands that the Customer is an equal opportunity employer and therefore maintains a policy which prohibits unlawful discrimination based on race, color, creed, sex, age, national origin, physical handicap, disability, genetic information, or any other consideration made unlawful by federal, state, or local laws. All such discrimination is unlawful and the Vendor agrees during the term of the Agreement that the Vendor will strictly adhere to this policy in its employment practices and provision of services. The Vendor shall comply with, and all activities under this Agreement shall be subject to, all applicable federal, State of Mississippi, and local laws and regulations, as now existing and as may be amended or modified.

For the faithful performance of the terms of this Agreement, the parties have caused this Agreement to be executed by their undersigned representatives.

REQUEST:

Pursuant to the Mississippi Codes Annotated, 1972 § Title 21, Chapter 19, Section 11: Staff requests that the City Council set a public hearing date for March 17, 2015. The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether property or parcel of land located within a municipality is in such a state of uncleanliness as to be a menace to the public health, safety and welfare of the community.

BACKGROUND:

The property has been abandoned and has an open swimming pool which is a safety concern. The swimming pool is full of water and has dilapidated plywood over the top of the pool with large gaps.

Residents continue to complain about the property and staff have received reports that a dog fell in the pool and could not get out of the pool until retrieved by the owner. The dog was missing for over twenty-four hours.

This address has been an perpetual code violation case since 2009.

DISCUSSION:

The primary goal is to secure the swimming pool, clean up the property, and maintain the overgrown property condition as necessary.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends City Council hold a public hearing on March 17, 2015, in order to determine the property a menace to the public health, safety, and welfare of citizens and direct Staff to commence with abatement/clean up of the overgrown property and securing the swimming pool.

Mississippi Code of 1972, Section 21-19-11, provides procedures to municipalities to clean private property determined to be a menace to those in the municipal community thus:

Section 1. Section 21-19-11, Mississippi Code of 1972 is amended as follows:

(1) To determine whether property or parcel of land located within a municipality is in such a state of uncleanness as to be a menace to the public health, safety and welfare of the community, a governing authority of any municipality shall conduct a hearing, on its own motion, or upon the receipt of a petition signed by a majority of the residents residing within four hundred (400) feet of any property or parcel of land alleged to be in need of the cleaning. Notice shall be provided to the property owner by:

(a) United States mail two (2) weeks before the date of the hearing mailed to the address of the subject property and to the address where the ad valorem tax notice for such property is sent by the office charged with collecting ad valorem tax; and

(b) Posting notice for at least two (2) weeks before the date of a hearing on the property or parcel of land alleged to be in need of cleaning and at city hall or another place in the municipality where such notices are posted.

Any notice required by this section shall include language that informs the property owner that an adjudication at the hearing that the property or parcel of land is in need of cleaning will authorize the municipality to reenter the property or parcel of land for a period of one (1) year after the hearing without any further hearing if notice is posted on the property or parcel of land and at city hall or another place in the municipality where such notices are generally posted at least seven (7) days before the property or parcel of land is reentered for cleaning. A copy of the required notice mailed and posted as required by this section shall be recorded in the minutes of the governing authority in conjunction with the hearing required by this section.

If, at such hearing, the governing authority shall adjudicate the property or parcel of land in its then condition to be a menace to the public health, safety and welfare of the community, the governing authority, if the owner does not do so himself, shall proceed to clean the land, by the use of municipal employees or by contract, by cutting grass and weeds; filling cisterns; removing rubbish, dilapidated fences, outside toilets, dilapidated buildings, personal property, which removal of personal property shall not be subject to the provisions of Section 21-39-21, and other debris; and draining cesspools and standing water there from. The governing authority may by resolution adjudicate the actual cost of cleaning the property and may also impose a penalty not to exceed One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) or fifty percent (50%) of the actual cost, whichever is more. The cost and any penalty may become a civil debt against the property owner, or, at the option of the governing authority, an assessment against the property. The "cost assessed against the property" means either the cost to the municipality of using its own employees to do the work or the cost to the municipality of any contract executed by the municipality to have the work done, and administrative costs and legal costs of the municipality.

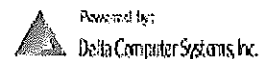
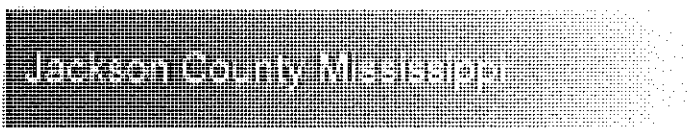
For subsequent cleaning within the one-year period after the date of the hearing at which the property or parcel of land was adjudicated in need of cleaning, upon seven (7) days' notice posted both on the property or parcel of land adjudicated in need of cleaning and at city hall or another place in the municipality where such notices are generally posted, and consistent with the municipality's adjudication as authorized in this subsection (1), a municipality may reenter the property or parcel of land to maintain cleanliness without further notice or hearing no more than six (6) times in any twelve-month period with respect to removing dilapidated buildings, dilapidated fences and outside toilets, and no more than twelve (12) times in any twenty-four-month period with respect to cutting grass and weeds and removing rubbish, personal property and other debris on the land, and the expense of cleaning of the property shall not exceed an aggregate amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) per year, or the fair market value of the property subsequent to cleaning, whichever is less. The governing authority may assess the same penalty for each time the property or land is cleaned as otherwise provided in this section. The penalty provided herein shall not be assessed against the State of Mississippi upon request for reimbursement under Section 29-1-145, nor shall a municipality clean a parcel owned by the State of Mississippi without first giving notice.

(2) If the governing authority declares, by resolution, that the cost and any penalty shall be collected as a civil debt, the governing authority may authorize the institution of a suit on open account against the owner of the property in a court of competent jurisdiction in the manner provided by law for the cost and any penalty, plus court costs, reasonable attorney's fees and interest from the date that the property was cleaned.

(3) If the governing authority does not declare that the cost and any penalty shall be collected as a civil debt, then the assessment above provided for shall be a lien against the property and may be enrolled in the office of the circuit clerk of the county as other judgments are enrolled, and the tax collector of the municipality shall, upon order of the board of governing authorities, proceed to sell the land to satisfy the lien as now provided by law for the sale of lands for delinquent municipal taxes.

(4) All decisions rendered under the provisions of this section may be appealed in the same manner as other appeals from municipal boards or courts are taken.

(5) Nothing contained under this section shall prevent any municipality from enacting criminal penalties for failure to maintain property so as not to constitute a menace to public health, safety and welfare.

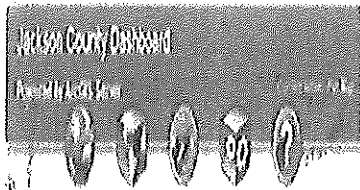

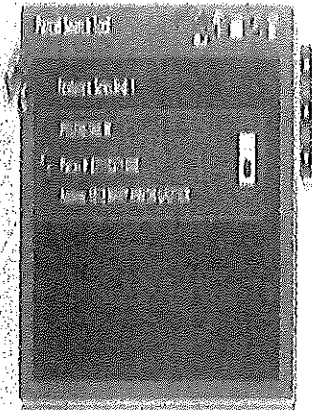

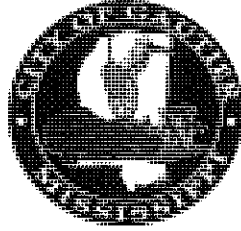

The purpose of the hearing is to listen to testimony and determine if the property meets the requirements outlined in Mississippi Code Annotated 1972 § Title 21, Chapter 19, Section 11.

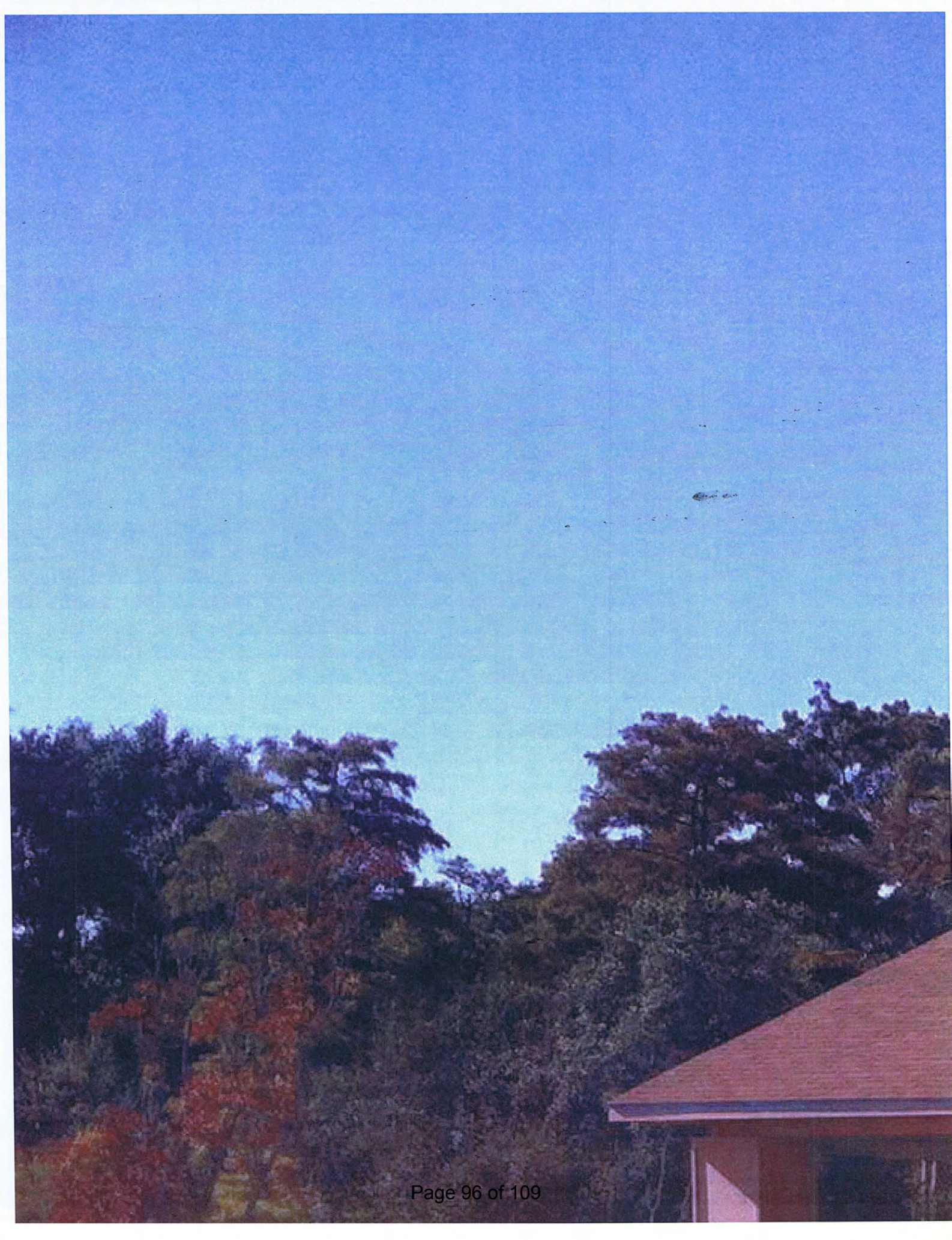

RESOLUTION NUMBER 007-2015

RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1722 PASSED IN 2013 REGULAR SESSION OF THE MISSISSIPPI LEGISLATURE TO ELIMINATE THE REPEAL CLAUSE CONTAINED THEREIN, OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, TO EXTEND THE REPEAL DATE IN ORDER TO AFFORD THE CITY COUNCIL ADDITIONAL TIME WITHIN WHICH TO ALLOW THE OPPORTUNITY FOR A REFERENDUM ON THE ISSUE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 1722, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as an exhibit, was passed in the 2013 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature authorizing the City Council of the City of Gautier, Mississippi (City) to levy a tax not to exceed two (2%) percent on the gross proceeds derived from the sale of prepared foods by restaurants in the City, and upon the gross sales of hotels and motels derived from room rentals, the proceeds of which tax are to be used for the purpose of providing funds to improve parks and recreation facilities for the purpose of tourism and economic development within the city; and

WHEREAS, since the passage of the aforesaid House Bill 1722, a new City Council was elected to office in June of 2013 and assumed office on July 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its terms, House Bill 1722 will “sunset” in July, 2016; and

WHEREAS, these funds are necessary to fund the City of Gautier’s Master Recreation Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City Council to fund said plan, it is necessary that there be a funding source available, and the amount of time left until the expiration of House Bill 1722 is insufficient to that purpose:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Gautier respectfully requests that the repeal provision set forth in House Bill 1722, which was passed by the Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature in

2013, be either removed in its entirety, or that an extension be granted so as to give the present City Council additional time within which to hold a referendum thereon and, if the same is successful, to allow sufficient time for this new revenue source to be used to implement the Master Recreation Facility Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be sent to each member of the local legislative delegation.
